RECYCLE

What

- Glass, cans, cardboard, paper, plastic
 - Rinse bottles and cans
 - Paper & cardboard must not be soiled e.g. with food residue

See the website for a complete list of items accepted or refused

How

- Deposit in recycle containers
- Leave unbagged or use clear plastic bags

SCRAP METAL

What

- Items containing steel, aluminum, etc.

How

- Deposit in the scrap metal bin

ELECTRONICS

What

- Computers, printers, phones, etc.

How

- See the Attendant

COMPOST

Materials Accepted

Food: Fresh or expired food, cooked or raw, including meat, fish and seafood, as well as bones, skin & fat

Plants: Dead leaves, grass, flowers, plants, weeds, twigs, sawdust, shavings and bark (no large branches)

Paper and cardboard: Unwaxed and soiled with food waste; paper plates, pizza boxes, compostable paper bags

Others: Hair, cooled ashes, cat litter and animal excrement

How

- Deposit in the green compost bins
- Leave unbagged or use compostable paper bags

Materials Refused

Plastic Bags: Including those labeled "compostable", "biodegradable" or "oxo biodegradable"

Others: Diapers, sanitary napkins, Q-tips, dental floss, medication, masks, gloves, wax or parchment paper, animal carcasses, large branches, rocks, textiles, dust, chewing gum, cigarettes, cork, oyster or mussel shells, all construction and renovation materials

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

What

- Oils, paint, batteries

How

- See the Attendant

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

What

- Lumber, drywall, insulation, etc.
 - Asphalt shingles not accepted

How

- See the Attendant

OTHER

What

- Large branches, tires, furniture

How

- See the Attendant

GARBAGE

What

- Generally anything not included in the prior categories is Garbage
- Styrofoam (check website)
- Ask the Attendant if you are unsure

How

- Deposit in the garbage bin

Starting January, 2025, garbage must be in clear plastic bags
