NEED A PERMIT?

All new construction, demolition, renovations, septic systems, wells and subdivisions **REQUIRE** a permit. Please contact the Building Inspector, Gabi Morin, at 819-453-7049.

DOG & CAT TAGS:

Does your pet have a tag? Tags are available at the Municipal Office. Tags are required to identify your pet should they be picked up by our Animal Control Officer. Cost is \$20 and must be purchased annually.

Open Air fire dates (without a fire pit): November 15 to March 15 of each year with a **permit**. Permits can be obtained from the Inspector at the Municipal Office.

FIREWORKS:

Did you know that fireworks are only permitted during certain holidays? Victoria Day long weekend (May), Quebec National day (June 24th), Canada Day (July 1), Civic Holiday weekend (August) and Labour Day weekend (Sept.). Call the Municipal Inspector for a copy of the by-law for more information.

OVERNIGHT PARKING:

Did you know that you cannot park a vehicle overnight (Midnight to 6AM) during the winter period (15 Nov. to 15 Apr.) on any municipal road, according to Municipal By-law 2016-12-09 and SQ By-law 2011-01.

Recycling & Composting: The Municipality of Otter Lake has implemented a composting program. The provincial Government will be reducing our funding if we do not continue working on our program. Increased recycling and composting will reduce garbage costs and allow us to maintain our low waste service charges to the tax payer. The Municipality purchased one composter in 2019 which was installed at the dump and plans to purchase another in 2020. **Boat Wash:** The Municipality has installed a boat wash station behind the municipal hall at our municipal garage. Please the wash your boat and protect our greatest asset, our lakes. <u>Invasive Species In Our Lakes:</u> Some plants and animals make lakes and rivers unsafe to swim in and will kill the fish. These plants and animals are called invasive species. Currently some lakes in neighbouring municipalities are infected by invasive species. Invasive species are easily transported from lake to lake by boats that have not been washed. Once a lake is infected it is very expensive to control and almost impossible to remove. The Municipality is working on processes to protect Otter Lake's lakes and rivers from becoming infected with invasive species. The success of the processes will require the support of all tax payers. <u>Farmers Market</u>: The municipality is considering a Farmers

Tax payments:

Due April 1, 2020. Payable in 3 installments if the amount exceeds \$300.00, April 1, July 1 and September 1, 2020. Our system accepts postdated checks should you wish to send in your 3 installments at once. Forms of payment accepted are: cash, check, debit and online payments with most major
